

Directions to Main Campus

AUTOMOBILE

From the North:

Dan Ryan (I-90/94) Expressway East to the 31st Street exit. Turn left (East) on 31st, then, turn right (South) on State Street. Metered parking is available in the Visitor's Parking Lot (Lot A4) located at 32nd Street and State Street, on the East (left) side of State Street.

Or:

Use the Lake Shore Drive directions below.

From the South:

Dan Ryan (I-90/94) Expressway West to the 35th Street exit. Turn right (East) on 35th, then, turn left (North) on State Street. Metered parking is available in the Visitor's Parking Lot (Lot A4) located at 32nd Street and State Street, on the East (left) side of State Street.

Or:

Dan Ryan (I-90/94) Expressway to the Stony Island Ave exit and continue on Stony Island Ave. Merge onto Cornell Ave toward Lake Shore Drive (US-41). Continue on Cornell Ave until it becomes 57th St. Continue on 57th St. towards Lake Shore Drive. Turn left onto Lake Shore Drive North. Exit at 31st Street, go inland (West) to State Street, and turn left (South). Metered parking is available in the Visitor's Parking Lot (Lot A4) located at 32nd Street and State Street, on the East (left) side of State Street.

Note: As of April 1, 2006, the Dan Ryan Expressway (Interstate 90/94 south of the Loop) will be under construction. The City of Chicago and the Office of Undergraduate Admission at IIT advise you to take alternate routes to get to campus. The website avoidtheryan.com can direct you to alternate routes.

From Lake Shore Drive:

Lake Shore Drive South and exit at 31st Street. Go inland (West) to State Street, turn left (South). Metered parking is available in the Visitor's Parking Lot (Lot A4) located at 32nd Street and State Street, on the East (left) side of State Street.

AIRPORTS

IIT and Chicago are served by O'Hare International Airport and Midway International Airport. Public transportation is available from O'Hare and Midway airports, and limousine or taxi will take you from all airports to IIT's campus. RAPID TRANSIT

The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) has buses and trains (trains known as the "L") which run throughout Chicago and reach out to the near Chicago suburbs and the two metropolitan airports. IIT is reachable by two "L" lines and many buses.

- CTA Red Line (Howard-Dan Ryan) to Sox/35th Street station
- CTA Green Line (Ashland/63rd or East 63/ Cottage Grove) to 35th Street/Bronzeville station
- Bus lines with stops on IIT's Campus (#29-State, #35-35th, #24-Wentworth, #4-Cottage Grove, #1-Michigan)

METRA AND AMTRAK TRAINS

Amtrak and Metra Rail trains run to Union Station, with Metra Rail trains running to Ogilvie Transportation Center as well. From these stations, take CTA's public transportation or a taxi to IIT's Main Campus.
